Welcome to the COOKIES POLICY of **MIMPO GLOBAL LOGISTICS, SL** website, with CIF B88307558, where we will explain in clear and simple language all of the necessary FAQ's so that you can have a better understanding according to your personal decisions.

WHAT ARE COOKIES AND WHAT DO WE USE THEM FOR?

A cookie or computer cookie is a small information file that is saved on your computer, smartphone or tablet every time you visit our website. In principle, a cookie is harmless: it does not contain viruses, Trojans, worms, etc. that may harm your terminal, but it does have a certain impact on your right to the protection of your personal data. Since cookies collect certain information concerning you (browsing habits, identity, preferences, etc.).

That is why, based on what is established in the standard means it is applied. LSSI and standard together means your personal data is being protected, the activation of certain cookies will require your prior authorization. Before that, we will give you some additional information that will help you make better decisions.

1. There are various types of cookies depending on their purpose:

- Technical cookies are necessary for our website to work, they do not need your authorization and are the only ones that we have activated by default.

- The rest of cookies serve to improve our page, to personalize it based on your preferences, or to be able to show you advertising tailored to your searches, taste and personal interests.

You can accept these cookies by checking or unchecking the related box, and then clicking on SAVE or configuring them or rejecting their use afterwards by clicking on the CHANGE COOKIES CONFIGURATION section.

2. Some cookies are ours (we will call them our own cookies) and others belong to external companies that provide services for our website (we will call them third-party cookies: an example could be cookies from external providers such as Google).

In this sense, it is important that you know that some of these external providers may be located outside of Spain.

Globally, not all countries have the same level of data protection, some countries are safer than others (for example, the European Union is a safe environment for your data). Our policy is to use reliable suppliers that, regardless of whether or not they are located within the European Union, have adopted the appropriate guarantees for the protection of your personal information. However, in the section called WHAT KIND OF COOKIES ARE CURRENTLY USED ON OUR WEBSITE ?, you can consult the different privacy and data protection policies for each of the aforementioned external providers, in order to make a conscious decision about the activation or not of third-party cookies that use our website.

3. Finally, indicated that, depending on the period of time they remain active, cookies can be of two types:

- Session cookies: they expire automatically when you end the session on your computer, smartphone or tablet. They are usually used to keep the necessary information while you are being provided with a service on only one occasion.

- Persistent cookies: they remain stored on your computer, smartphone or tablet for a certain period, which can vary from a few minutes to several years.

WHAT KIND OF COOKIES DO WE USE ON OUR WEBSITE?

• **Technical Cookies:** Technical cookies are strictly necessary for our website to function and you can navigate through it. These types of cookies are those that, for example, allow us to identify you, give you access to certain restricted parts of the page if necessary, or remember different options or services already selected, such as your privacy preferences.

Therefore, they are activated by default, and your authorization is not necessary. Through the configuration of your browser, you can block or alert the presence of this type of cookies, although blocking will affect the correct operation of the different functionalities of our website.

• **Analysis Cookies:** Analysis cookies allow us to study the navigation of users of our website in general (for example, which sections of the page are most visited, which services are used the most and if they work correctly, etc.).

From the statistical information on browsing our website, we can improve both the operation of the page and the different services it offers.

Therefore, these cookies do not have an advertising purpose, but only serve to make our website work better, adapting to our users in general. By activating them you will contribute to such continuous improvement. You can enable or disable these cookies by checking the corresponding box, being disabled by default.

WHAT KIND OF COOKIES ARE CURRENTLY USED ON OUR WEBSITE?

Next, we proceed to inform you about all the types of cookies currently used on our website and the purpose of each of them:

WHAT CAN YOU DO WITH COOKIES?

When you access our website for the first time, a window is displayed in which we inform you that there may be several types of cookies:

- Technical cookies are necessary for our website to function, they do not require your authorization and they are the only ones that we have activated by default.

The rest of cookies serve to improve our page, to personalize it based on your preferences, or to be able to show you advertising tailored to your searches, taste and personal interests.

You can accept all these cookies by checking or unchecking the related box, and then clicking SAVE.

Also to inform you that, once you have activated any type of cookies, you have the possibility to deactivate it at the time you want, with the simple step of unchecking the corresponding box in the CHANGE COOKIES CONFIGURATION section of our website. It will always be as easy to activate our own cookies and deactivate them.

Also remember that, through the configuration of your browser, you can block the alerts of the presence of cookies, although said blocking may affect the correct operation of the different functionalities of our website in the case of the necessary technical cookies.

Finally, indicated that if you activate third-party cookies (external companies that provide services for our website) and subsequently you wish to deactivate them, you can do so in two ways: using the cookie deactivation tools of your browser or through the enabled systems themselves by said external providers.
